#### Introduction

In facing rapid growth in service business in the global market especially in the fields of e-commerce/e-business and logistics/supply chain, it is necessary to provide graduates to fill the growing demand for professionals in the service business which is equipped with higher cognitive skills and social and emotional skills. The Program has had international business school accreditation (AACSB) and national BAN-PT 'UNGGUL' accreditation. The uniqueness of this program is strengthening the students with "digital service and supply chain management". The service orientation and supply chain will be crucial future competencies for any company, namely the competencies in developing integrated solutions for customer problems (service orientation), including managing the internal and external parties (supply chain) and use of the latest technology in the process (digital). Therefore, the competencies will be a key competitive advantage for any company. The students will also get the updated knowledge and experience from industries and soft-skills trainings/workshops that enable them to survive and expand their capacity. The learning process is carried out through a variety of teaching-learning strategies encompasses business case study, business simulations, laboratory, collaborative learning, international guest lecturer, industry visit, role playing, free-elective course and enrichment program or KAMPUS MERDEKA.

# **Prospective Career of the Graduates**

Graduates of Business Management Program will have prospective careers particularly as e-commerce development, business development, logistics/supply chain analyst, procurement/purchasing analyst, business

analyst, human resource development, business consultant, and service provider (servpreneur). The graduates also have competency in carrying out transformation from a conventional business to be a service business as business (servitization) analyst.

### Curriculum

Curriculum of Business Management Program has been designed to meet today's global business challenges, especially in the service business by embedding 80% of general competencies (management concepts, creative thinking and entrepreneurial skills, global mindset, and ethics) and 20% of specific competencies (digital service and supply chain management). The curriculum also encompasses 70% of class-based learning and 30% real practices. Class-based learning (face-to-face and online/GSLC) will be delivered in semester 1-5. In semester 5, the students will also get 4 SCU (SKS) for free elective courses namely the courses that can be elected by students according to their own interest from all courses offered by all programs (outside Business Management Program) at BINUS University. In semester 6-7, the students will get enrichment program (3+1 Program) with 6 tracks or options (internship, research, startup, community service, study abroad, or further study). In semester 8, the students must complete their thesis. In the program, on-time study is 4 years or 8 semesters. The students will be able to graduate faster (3.5 years or 7 semesters) if their minimum GPA is 2.75 by completing their thesis in semester 7. The Program also offers (international) professional certification in the fields of sustainability report, service management and logistics/supply chain management. In designing supply chain management syllabus, we have collaborated with Kühne Foundation (Switzerland) and HAN University (Netherlands).
